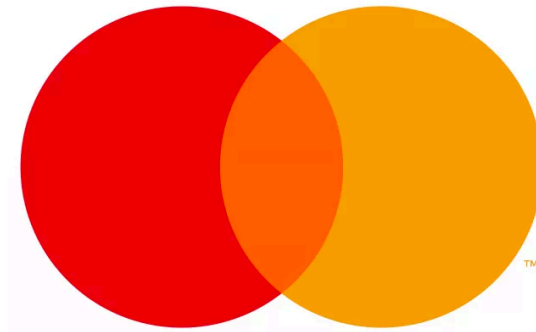

Did you know...

Signs of human trafficking:

- Not getting paid for their labor
- Not free to leave their job, or to come and go as they please
- Not in control of their identification documents
- Few or no personal possessions or financial records
- Owes a large debt and unable to pay it back
- Was recruited through false promises about the nature of their work
- Limited knowledge of the community they are in or their location
- Forced to do something they don't want to do
- Shows signs of physical abuse, malnourishment, restraint, branding (tattoos, burns, etc.)
- Is under 18 and engaged in commercial sex
